Tripp will talk about and demonstrate Esri's new Web AppBuilder which has been added to ArcGIS Online. The new Web AppBuilder allows you to create custom web applications without having to program. These web apps can include a wealth of functionality from simple layer controls to complex queries.

The GISP Certification underwent the first major revision to its requirements since it was first released. This includes a new test, updated fees, a new renewal cycle and more. Tripp will help to clear the water on all these new changes and talk about some additional changes in the works that will add even more value to the certification. In addition, he can help answer any questions you may have concerning Esri's certification program as well.

Tripp Corbin is the CEO and a Co-founder of eGIS Associates, Inc. He has over 20 years of surveying, mapping and GIS related experience. He is recognized as an industry expert with a variety of geospatial software packages including Esri, Autodesk and Trimble products.
