10:10 **Michael Herr, GIS Analyst (City of Sumter)**

Faced with the need to provide accurate and up-to-date information about Sumter County's floodplains, while at the same time keeping costs down, GIS makes an effective tool for efficiently handling floodplain inquiries and communicating flood hazard risks to community members. This in turn allows citizens to make better informed decisions concerning flood prone properties and thereby reducing losses to flood hazards.

Michael Herr has been the GIS Analyst for the Sumter Planning Department for the last three years and has recently assumed the duties of the assistant Floodplain Manager. He works to integrate FEMA Flood Insurance Rates Maps with local data as part of a comprehensive floodplain management approach. This approach covers each phase of floodplain development from the initial permitting stage and building inspections to long term record management of LOMCs and Elevation Certificates. His work mapping abandoned and vacant housing in Sumter won him the SCAPA 2010 Outstanding Planning Project Award for the Innovative Use of Technology. He is a graduate of Binghamton University with a Master's Degree in Urban Planning with an emphasis on Water Resource Management.
