BIOS

James D. Scurry, Ph.D.

Jim received his Ph.D. and MS degrees from the University of South Carolina in Geographic Information Science and his Bachelor's degree from USC in Anthropology/Archaeology. He has been involved in Computer Mapping, GIS and spatial sciences since the late 1970s. During his professional career, he has worked for the SC Institute of Archaeology and Anthropology (SCIAA/USC), the National Wetlands Research Center of the US Fish and Wildlife Service in Louisiana and the SC Department of Natural Resources until his retirement in 2015. At the DNR, Jim partnered with various federal agencies in the development of statewide GIS databases including soils, wetlands, DLGs, DOQQs, & LiDAR still in use today. Since retiring, he has continued to be involved in GIS providing consulting services to the SC Conservation Bank, SCJAA, and Southern Eighths Farm and in 2022 was appointed as a Research Affiliate with the Native American Studies Center at USC-Lancaster where he is working with Archaeologist Chris Judge using GIS and remote sensing to support archaeological research in the Santee and Pee Dee basins.

Trip Corbin is the GIS and Aerial Business Development Manager for Survey and Mapping LLC, also known as SAM. With over 28 years of Surveying, Mapping, and GIS experience, Mr. Corbin is recognized as an industry expert and has assisted various organizations use and implement GIS throughout the US and Canada.
